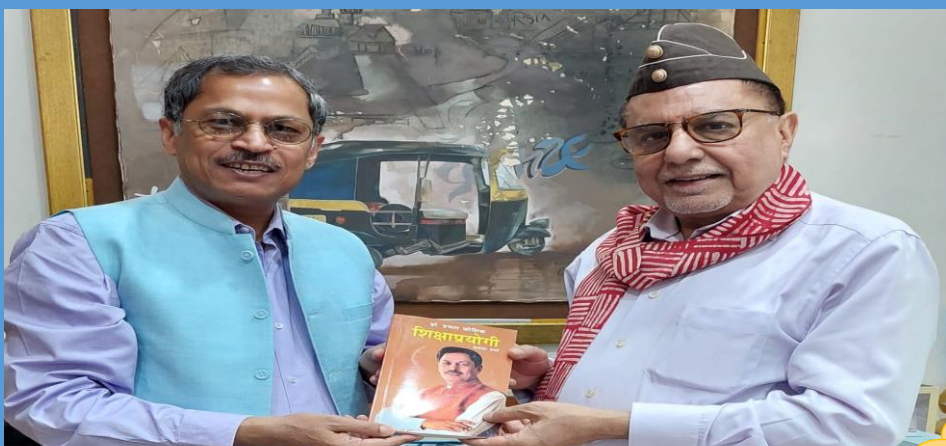
UCSKM is a symbol of progressive and quality education.

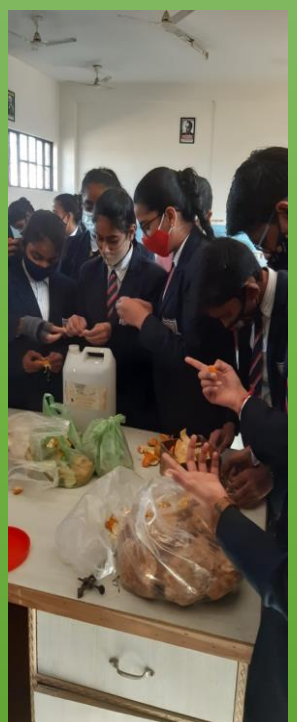


Synthesis of Bio Enzyme

Everyone showed gratitude to their mothers and were filled with emotions.

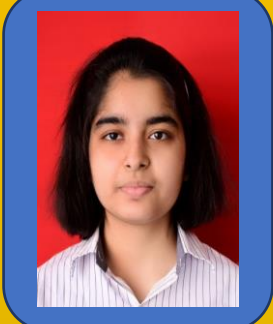
Not only our mothers but we should give respect to each and every mother of this world.

Resource person: Mrs Zena Chauhan

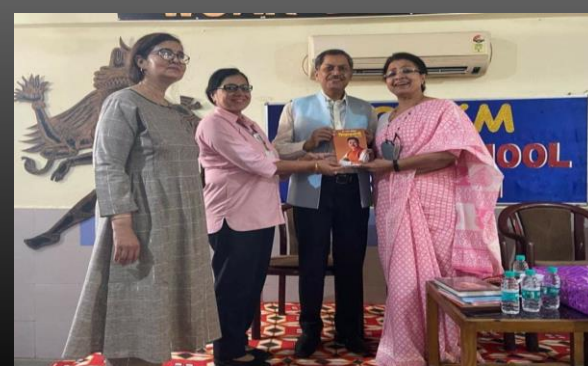

June 19th, 2022

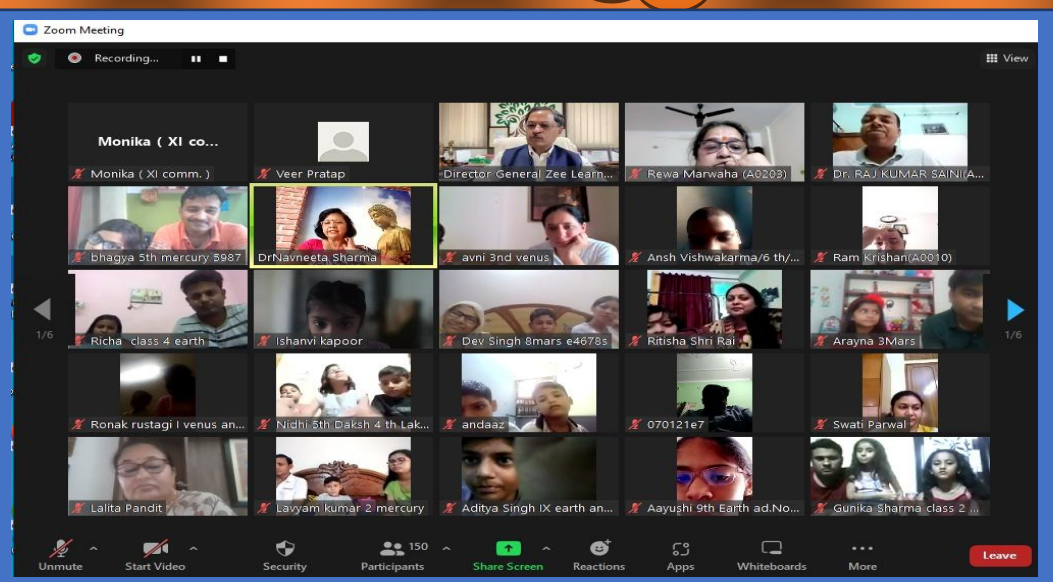


"Life doesn't come with an instruction book, that's why we have fathers" — Jackson Browne

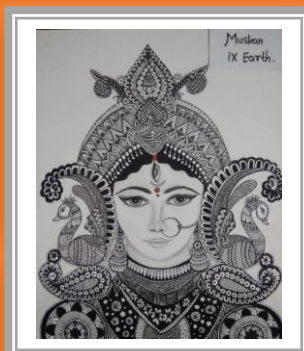
The session indeed rejuvenated the body for the whole day. We must Yoga everyday for a Healthy and Happy lifestyle.

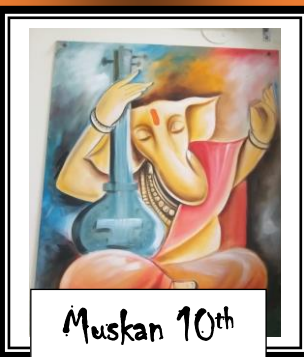

Mridul Sharma has made mobile control portable E-Bin with Arduino Uno, Ultrasonic sensor and Bluetooth

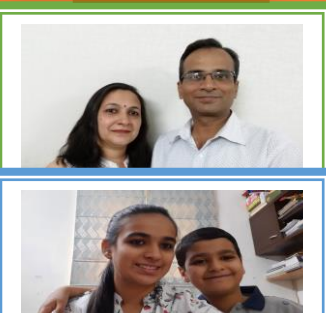
PARENT'S FEEDBACK
