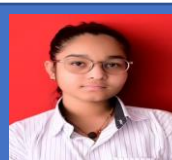
Under the auspices of Bharat Vikas Parishad, the students of our school kept earthen water-bowls for the thirsty birds in the school premises.

NATIONAL TECHNOLOGY DAY

The Government of India celebrates 11th May as 'National Technology Day' every year.

The celebration of this event this year extended up to 14th May as 'The National Technology Week', commemorating 25th year of the 'National Technology Day'. It aimed at showcasing the Scientific achievements of technology- breakthrough since 2014. The theme of this event was- 'School to Start -Up-Igniting young minds to innovate'.

UCSKM students gathered in the Atal Tinkering Lab and accelerated their knowledge gaining technological innovations. They attended a live telecast session by the Honourable Prime Minister of India Mr. Narendra Modi. He had laid the foundation of multiple scientific projects worth more than ₹5800 crore. During the session, he motivated the students to join live tinkering sessions- activities and hone their potentials in many zones like AR/VR, Defence Tech, Digi Yatra, Textiles and Life Sciences etc. The students were inspired to do their best as they came to know about the remarkable achievements of Indian scientists, engineers and researchers. Surely, it was an enriching experience.

CBSE Training Programmes

Learning Outcomes and Pedagogies

A CBSE workshop on “Pedagogy and Learning Outcomes” was organized on 28th June 2023, in our school. The Resource Persons were Mrs. Sarita Singh, Principal -RPS School, Behror and Mr. Rajan Sharma from Birla School, Pilani. Firstly, Madam Sarita Singh told about the learning outcomes in general. Differences between the learning outcomes and learning objectives were also discussed in detail. Then she described about how learning outcomes have far- reaching effects in the students' life.

Next, Mr. Rajan Sharma continued the same topic by telling the participants more regarding the pedagogy methods and learning outcomes. In order to make the workshop interesting, the resource persons used various videos, stories and fun-filled activities. All the teachers participated actively in the workshop. Feedback was taken towards the end of the session.

The workshop concluded with the vote of thanks, presented by Dr Navneeta Sharma.

The information gathered at the workshop will definitely help all the teachers to prepare their lesson plans well.

National Education Policy (NEP)

UCSKM Public School organized one full day workshop on New National Education Policy 2020 on 30th June 2023 in the school activity hall. To help the teachers understand its nuances, curriculum changes, shift in the pedagogical skills and its implementation for the 360 degree holistic development of its stakeholders, the students.

The session began with the welcome note and introduction of the eminent Resource Persons Dr Nidhi Phogat and Mrs Riju Srivastava who are a renowned name in the field of education for their expertise and experience and an expert in conducting various competency building programs for mentoring the teachers, by the Vice Principal Dr Navneeta Sharma

Ms Nidhi Phogat started her session by mentioning the fact that Shri Narendra Modi approved the National Education Policy-2020 on July 29, 2020. She then added that Educational Policy-2020 seeks to introduce and implement a sea of changes across all levels of education in India, including the essential understanding of education in the country. Further she apprised the educators that the New Education Policy is based on the pillars of “access, equity, quality, affordability, accountability” and it will radically transform India into a “vibrant knowledge hub”. She talked about the PISA and Skill development programs for preparing future ready students. that the New Education policy came into existence. The main objective of this Workshop was to create awareness about the newly launched National Education Policy-2020 amongst teachers and to familiarize them with the skills. She shed light on the creation of a new structure in place of old, i.e., replacing 10+2 with 5+3+3+4. She shared that the substantial impetus placed on vocational education or hands-on learning in the new policy will give rise to multiple hybrid jobs. With the rapid progression of information technology, and to be able to offer the students a much broader, multidisciplinary foundation, she expressed the importance of using a holistic and multidisciplinary learning approach which will help the learners adapt and reinvent themselves to the demands of the new hybrid work culture and dynamic socio-cultural changes. She discussed about the redesigned report cards which will be a “holistic, 360-degree, multidimensional report that would reflect in great detail of the progress, skills and uniqueness of each learner in the cognitive, affective and psychomotor domains. She also added that the progress report will include self-assessment, peer assessment and teacher assessment. The NEP has introduced integration of Experiential learning, Competency based education and Art and Sport Integrated Education which was always present in our Indian Culture since the days of Gurukul. Furthermore Ms. Riju shared the vision of the NEP's measures to introduce Early Childhood Education (ECCE) from age 3, the FLM, bag less days, internships for promoting vocational skills ,and the offer of school board examinations twice a year to reduce the pressure and help improve students' understanding and performance. NEP emphasizes to move students away from rote learning, and raise literacy and numeracy skills at the foundational level. Every student will start achieving age-appropriate foundational literacy and numeracy (FLN) by 2025. A slew of programmes and measures are articulated for this purpose. FLN programme will help in Oral language development, decoding sounds and symbols, reading fluency, reading comprehension and writing. Bloom's taxonomy was explained in details which helped to understand and use it to analyse, understand and evaluate the child's performance.

Ms. Riju concluded the session by emphasizing on the challenges faced in New Education Policy – 2020. She also shared that pedagogical structures will be designed anew to be more appropriate and effective, based on children's cognitive and socio-emotional development. The curriculum will be integrated and flexible with equal emphasis on all subjects and fields. There will be no separation of curricular, co-curricular or extra-curricular areas—with all in a single category of equal importance. Vocational and academic streams will be integrated and offered to all students. Examination systems will be radically changed to assess real learning, make them stress-free, and aim for improvement instead of the passing of judgments.

Dr Prabhat Kaushik, the Principal, UCSKM Public School proposed the vote of thanks. It was a very enriching and informative session. All the participants were filled with new zeal to start working on its implementation in their own spheres.
