

There was no respect for youth,
when I was young, and now that I
am old, there is no respect for age
I missed it coming and going.



In the current era we all are passing through a difficult time. As kids, we were always taught to be careful for others' emotions and respect, especially to our elders, not only in the family but also in the whole community. It used to be a daily routine for us to take care of everyone around us. There were numerous occasions where someone used to correct us; even the neighbours who were our extended families, had the right to check us through hard ways and punishments. Our parents always supported the person who checked us for the right cause. The good thing we had realised later in life was that the process of correcting us in childhood was quite useful and scientific, as we were being inadvertently trained to deal with stress and ego. We were being raised in a society, by the society and for the society in a righteous manner as the feeling of being together was imbibed day in and day out by crushing our egos early in life. The qualities of stress management, managing people around us, tolerance and not shying away from taking help in case of need were the few outputs of such parenting. In contrast to our childhood, if we analyse the current scenario wherein most kids are being raised in isolation, they are full of ego with a selfish and 'myself' attitude .They grow weak, because of not being social, not being available to family and each other in good and bad times. No one seems to have the authority to correct the wrong doings of children, including those who are supposed to take ownership of raising strong and well behaved children. In some cases, including parents, teachers, grandparents, uncles, aunts, cousins and even siblings nowadays, are unable to suggest corrections. The attitude of 'me/ myself' and 'no one else', seems to replace the philosophy of being in, by and for the society.





Unfortunately, children are being raised in isolation with an abundance of pampering, resulting in feeble mindsets. The children raised in such an environment cannot learn to take care of themselves and the people around them, including their own grandparents and parents. The sad part is they have no one to look upon in crisis.

However, it is important for us to be in such a slot, to raise responsible citizens for our society.

It is the reality of the present scenario and I have taken the responsibility of developing FEARLESS, SELF DISCIPLINED AND EGO-FREE STUDENTS.

A NUCLEAR FAMILY consists of the following ELEMENTS:

NEUTRON: NEUTRAL: WITHOUT ANY CHARGE i.e. THE CHILD

P = PUNITIVE HABIT

P = PUNISHMENTS NEVER IMPROVE OTHERWISE POLICE STATIONS WOULD HAVE BEEN CLOSED LONG AGO

If you will continue your 'CLAPPING', our children will develop the following characters:

I = Immature, ignorant and impatient

N = notorious, nervous and negligent

G = grudge, grumpy, graceless



Instead of 'CLAPPING' give your child the 'SLAPPING'. It means;

S = SUPPORT

L = LOVE

A = ASSURANCE

P = PRAISE

SLAP (SUPPORTIVE, LOVING, FULL OF ASSURANCE and PRAISEWORTHY) will enhance positivity in children.

Further, if I add ING to the word SLAP children will become

P = PATIENT (Remain calm and not get angry)

I = IMPRESSIVE, INTELLIGENT AND INNOVATIVE

N = NOURISHING, NURTURED

G = GENTLE


Patience is the key to success. Our children will be successful in some profession according to their hidden potential. We cannot force a career on them.



Christmas Celebrations




On the 24th of December, a special assembly was organised in our school to celebrate Christmas.


