



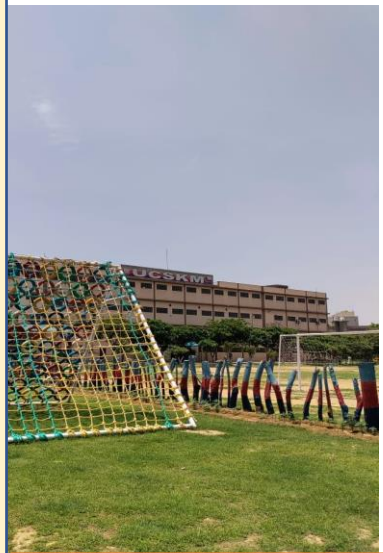

Annual function (*Rise and Thrive*)

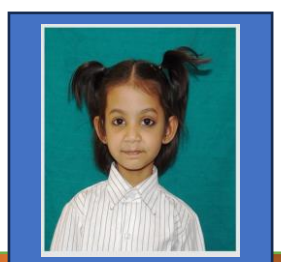

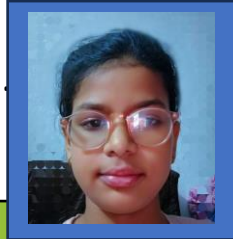

And your little love and care

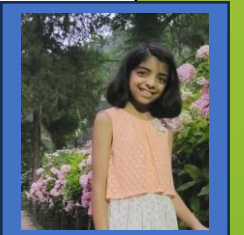
